Secondary School Realignment Task Force
June 15 2005

The Secondary School Realignment Task Force met at 6:30 p.m. on Wednesday, June 15, 2005, in Room 105 at the Administration Center, 315 E. North Drive, Bloomington.

Karin St. John reviewed discussion at the meeting on May 19. She explained that if the group's Norms and Principles were approved, information will be posted on the MCCSC web site with an e-mail link for people to contact the task force.

1. **Group Norms** – By consensus, the May 19 'draft' of "Group Norms" was approved.
2. **Principles of Realignment** – A draft dated May 19 was discussed briefly and approved by consensus with three minor changes. The Principles of Realignment will be posted on the MCCSC web site.
3. **Review Attendance Flow Charts** – Task Force members reviewed in detail the attendance area flow charts after elementary realignment. Discussion ensued regarding the possibility of moving some middle school boundaries to match elementary boundaries, especially in situations where only a few students would be attending a different middle school than their 6th grade classmates. Specific attention was given to 'observations' shared by the Elementary Realignment Task Force.

Task Force members also looked at numbers of students and capacity of each middle school and held preliminary discussions regarding how to achieve enrollment balance yet keep together as many elementary students as possible as they move to the middle school level.
