

***Narrative Description of the Boundary Line Changes  
Approved by the School Board 2/15/05***

1. 37 students in Basswood/Canterbury from HIG to ARL. This area includes all of Basswood Dr. and those streets that are connected to it. It includes Basswood and Canterbury apartments. These students will attend Arlington Elementary School.
2. 21 students along Curry Pike south of Farmer Ave. from HIG to GRA. This area begins at the intersection of Farmer Ave. and South Curry Pike (1800 S. Curry Pike.) This area includes all the streets that connect to Curry Pike from Farmer Ave. south to Hwy 45. These students will attend Grandview Elementary.
3. 34 students in Oakdale Square apartments from HIG to ARL. Oakdale Square apartments are located off Bloomfield Rd./2<sup>nd</sup> St. just east of Hwy. 37. All of Oakdale Drive, Spruce Drive, Pecan Lane and Birch Lane will attend Arlington Elementary.
4. 43 students in Heatherwood from BRO to GRA. All of Heatherwood Mobile Home Park on Leonard Springs Rd. will attend Grandview Elementary.
6. 15 students along Cory Lane and Anna Lee Lane from TEM to FAI. This area starts at Bloomfield Rd. and Cory Lane. All of Cory lane from Bloomfield Rd to 3<sup>rd</sup> St. is included. This also includes Anna Lee Lane and West 2<sup>nd</sup> St. between Bloomfield Rd. and 3<sup>rd</sup> St. These students will attend Fairview Elementary.
7. 68 students in the Highlands from CLE to SUM. The Highlands is the housing addition just north of Gordon Pike and west of Batchelor Middle School. All of the Highlands and Batchelor Heights will attend Summit Elementary.
8. 89 students from Eagle View and Clear Creek Estates from CLE to SUM. Eagle View and Clear Creek Estates are bordered on the north by Gordon Pike from Rogers St. west to the dead end. The eastern boundary is Rogers St. south to just past Baywood Drive in Clear Creek Estates. The boundary line would run diagonally southwest from Baywood and Rogers until it intersects with Eagle View Drive and That Rd. These students will attend Summit Elementary.
10. 22 students along Hwy 46 east from BIN/ROG to UNO. This area includes everything east of 7700 East Hwy 46. It includes Sewell, Kent, McGowan, Gilmore Ridge and Deckard Ridge Roads as well as Woodview and Conard Drives. These students will attend Unionville Elementary.
11. 57 students in Park Ridge East from BIN/ROG to UNI. The housing addition of Park Ridge East is bounded by Smith Rd. on the west and 3<sup>rd</sup> St on the south. All the houses as well as apartments and condominiums will be in the University Elementary district.
12. 32 students on Hwy 46 from BIN/ROG to UNI. This area begins at Lower Birdie Galyan Rd. and State Rd. 46. It includes Lower Birdie Galyan Rd. It also includes Getty's Creek Rd. from Hwy 46 north to the intersection with Kerr Ck. Rd. This also includes all the roads attached to Hwy. 46 from Birdie Galyan west to the intersection of Hwy 446. These students will attend University Elementary.

13. 9 students along 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> west of College Ave from BIN/ROG to TEM. This area is bounded by West 2<sup>nd</sup> St., South College Avenue, West 1<sup>st</sup> St. and Walker St. These students will attend Templeton Elementary.
16. 43 students from CHI to CLE starting at 4000 S Walnut St. Pike south to Fairfax Rd and then to Schact Rd. It includes Schact Rd. all the way to its intersection with Harrell Rd. It also includes all of Walnut St. Pike from Rhorer south to Fairfax Rd. It includes the Cardinal Glen and Sutton Place additions. These students will attend Clear Creek Elementary.
17. 21 students along Sare and Rhorer from CHI to BIN/ROG. This area includes Sare Rd. south of Rogers Rd. all the way to Rhorer Rd. All Sare Rd. addresses will attend Binford/Rogers. All streets whose only access in or out is from Sare Rd. will also attend Binford/Rogers. This area also includes both sides of Rhorer Rd. from Sare Rd. east to the intersection of Harrell Rd. and both sides of Rhorer west to Walnut St. Pk. It includes the Bridlewood subdivision. These students will attend Binford and Rogers Elementary.
