**Attendance Areas**

Students will attend the school in the attendance area where their parent or legal guardian resides. If the place of residence changes, the student will abide by the school assignment for the new place of residence. There is no grandfathering permitted for students **who change places of residence** unless that student is currently in the 11th grade. In this one instance the student may elect to complete his/her high school education at the previous high school, but must provide his/her own transportation if he/she elects this option.

**GRANDFATHER CLAUSE**

If a student is currently enrolled in a school (A) different from his or her 'post-realignment' school (B), that student may elect to matriculate from his/her present school (A), as long as that student provides his/her own transportation to that 'choice' school (A).

That student must attend his/her realigned school for the next level of education after matriculating from school (A). (i.e. Middle School, High School)

**Example:** Bob, a 7th grade student is currently enrolled in Jackson Creek Middle School and is scheduled to attend Bloomington High School South. Under the new realignment plan his middle school assignment is Tri-North Middle School and high school assignment is Bloomington High School North. Under the grandfather clause Bob may elect to complete his middle school education for Grade 8 at Jackson Creek Middle School under the grandfather clause and must provide his own transportation to Jackson Creek Middle School. However, since his high school assignment has changed, he must attend Bloomington High School North unless granted exemption under the Sibling Rule.

## SIBLING RULE

If a student has an older sibling currently attending an MCCSC school, that student may elect to attend that school through choice if it is different from his/her assigned school as dictated by the realignment plan if the attendance at that school is concurrent with the older sibling. If the enrollment at that school is not concurrent then that younger sibling **MUST** attend his/her assigned school. If attendance at an MCCSC school is through choice, not by assignment, then that student must provide his/her own transportation to that choice school.

**Example:** John and Mike are brothers. John is currently attending Bloomington High School South as a sophomore. Mike is currently attending Jackson Creek Middle School as a 7th grader. Under the realignment plan their residence is assigned to attend Tri-North Middle School/Bloomington High School North. Since John is enrolled at Bloomington High School South, he may complete his education there if he chooses, as long as he provides his own transportation. Mike elects to continue at Jackson Creek Middle School under the grandfather clause and graduates from Jackson Creek Middle School. Since his brother John is to be a senior at Bloomington High School South, Mike elects to attend there as well under the sibling rule. Subsequently John would be a senior at Bloomington High School South and Mike a freshman-their enrollment is concurrent. However, if John had graduated from Bloomington High School South before Mike arrived, their enrollment would not be concurrent and Mike must attend his post-realignment school, Bloomington High School North.

- It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to make all arrangements for transportation to and from school; and
- The student will arrive at and depart from school in a timely fashion. When school commences, the student should be in his/her seat ready to start class work. The student should depart promptly from school at dismissal time (or be enrolled in a bona fide after-school activity which will provide appropriate supervision for the student); and
- The student will comply with the receiving school's rules and regulations regarding attendance, behavior, and curricular expectations.

Violation of any of the aforementioned requirements may result in the revocation of this transfer agreement. In that event, the student must re-enroll in his/her home school or make other valid educational arrangements within three (3) school days. Signature of the Parent/Guardian below indicates agreement to all terms and conditions listed in this transfer.
