

CLASSROOM NORMS AND EXPECTATIONS

▣ Be fully *present*.

- Attend class on ALL designated school days.
- Be in the classroom when the bell rings.
 - 3rd tardy—parent contacted
 - 4th tardy—office referral (Friday school)
 - 5th tardy—office referral (in-school suspension)
 - 6th tardy (and beyond)—office referral (out-of-school suspension)
- Leave class when the teacher dismisses you, not when the bell rings.
- Follow all verbal and written directions.
- Stay on task.

▣ TAKE ***RESPONSIBILITY FOR YOUR OWN LEARNING***.

- Bring all required materials to class (i.e. folder, homework, pencil, etc.).
 - Turn in homework on time—late assignments will be accepted for partial credit no more than one day late.
 - Use PENCILS only.
- Do your OWN work.
 - Assignments not done solely by the student will receive a score of zero. In addition, the student or students cheating will be referred to the office.
- Carefully grade and correct your assignments.
- Do make-up work in a timely manner.

▣ If you wonder it, ... *ask* it.

▣ ***Support each other's learning.***

- Raise your hand to speak.
- Use discretion when going to the pencil sharpener, trashcan, etc.
- Encourage; do not discourage others.

▣ ***Take care of your personal needs.***

- Passes to the restroom, office, nurse, etc. can only be given using your agenda—no agenda, no pass out of the classroom.
