

Bell Work Instructions

Before you begin your bell work, copy down any assignments in your academic handbook.

Make sure that the holes on your paper are on the left side so that bell work will fit in your science folder.

1. Each Monday put the school heading on a clean sheet of notebook paper with "Bell Work" as the subject.
2. Put the date on the top line and underline it.
3. Write the bell work question/instruction or statement on the next line.
4. Answer the question/statement or perform the instruction.
Note you will not always have to write anything for step 4. If there is nothing to write down then you stop here and perform the instructions. (For example you instructions might be read pages ...)
5. The next day skip 2 lines and write the date and underline it.
6. Repeat steps 3 and 4.
7. Continue steps 2 through 5 each day until Friday.
8. Each Friday your bell work will be collected and graded.

Weekly bell work grades are worth 10 pts. That is 60 total points a grading period. Missing bell work cannot be made up. It is something you are to do daily at the beginning of class.

If you are absent please get the bell work questions that you missed from a classmate. If you are absent more than 2 days please see me for instructions.
