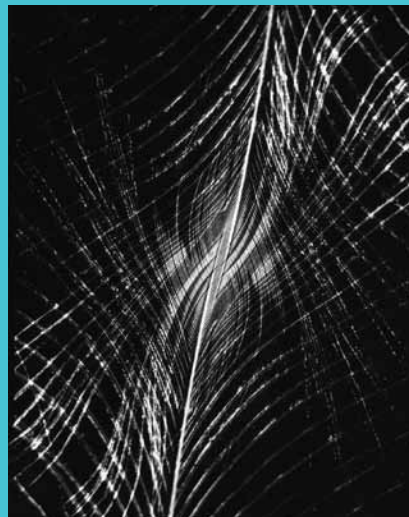

Entry Deadline 12.05.09

The contest is open to all high school students in the United States and will culminate in an exhibition at the photography program gallery in February 2010.

RULES

High school students may enter all types of photographic processes (black/white, color, silver prints, digital prints and historical processes). Each student may submit up to three matted photographs. **A \$20.00 entry fee for up to three entries per student is required. Checks are payable to Drexel University.** At this time we cannot accept credit cards for payment.

The outside dimensions of the mats **must** be 8x10 or 11x14. Each image must be accompanied by the supplied Entry Form with the title of the image, the artist's name and address, and the high school they are currently attending. Photographs must be sent in a resealable package with adequate packaging for return (or include new return packaging inside) and must include return postage. Entries that do not include return postage will not be returned. If a student is sending only one entry, it is advisable to use a bubble-type envelope with cardboard stiffeners to ship the matted photograph. Return packaging and postage must also be included.

All entries will be returned by April 1, 2010.

DEADLINE

All entries must be post marked by **December 5, 2009**. Accepted artists will be notified by January 9, 2010.

Photography program philosophy

We created our program to take advantage of the design education model of the Antoinette Westphal College of Media Arts and Design at Drexel, which emphasizes educating students in the manipulation of the tools of visual language and then relating these skills to the real-world environment. To this end, all photo students have: one full year of foundation design with two additional quarters of multi-media design; a one-year sequence of art history from classical antiquity to contemporary; two courses in drawing and a variety of visual studies electives. In addition, each student participates in a six-month co-op experience in their chosen field of study.

Recognizing that the aesthetics and the technology of photography should be mutually supportive, we have designed a program that seeks to provide aspiring photographers with a breadth of vision normally developed only in fine-arts programs. Additionally, our program provides students with solid technical and practical experience that will allow them to succeed in today's environment.

It is our intention that the fine-art and applied aspects of photography be seen as mutually interactive and supportive elements within our program. Our course of study provides the same

photography curriculum for all majors until well into the third year of study. In the junior year, students choose from advanced electives and create a path that will be followed during a full year senior thesis process. Students can pursue a career path that can include photojournalism, commercial photography, and fine-art exhibition.
