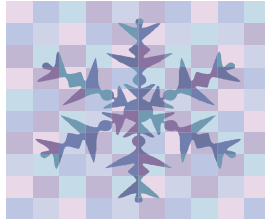


Hello Parents!

In addition to announcements through the media, you may call the school corporation general number, **330-7700, before 8:30 AM** to hear a recorded announcement. This recording will be made only if there is a cancellation. So if there is no special cancellation notice it means school is open and on schedule.

This year we will be using a **Snow Route** system. There are times when schools could be open but are not because buses cannot reach some remote areas of the school system. On some days we will announce that "schools are open but buses will be running **Snow Routes**." This means that buses will not run in these most difficult areas. Those few of you who will be affected by this will be contacted with the details in the near future.

Sometimes the weather can change rapidly and we want your children to be safe, so we send them home **early**. Please be sure that your child will be able to get into your home if he/she comes home early and no one is there. Discuss this with her/him in advance; plan with him/her in advance what she/he should do if this happens.
