<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Several sharp No. 2 pencils</li><li>● Black or blue pens for free response questions</li><li>● A watch that doesn't beep</li><li>● Up to two calculators (for list of approved calculators see): <a href="http://collegeboard.org/ap/calculators">collegeboard.org/ap/calculators</a></li><li>● A ruler for Physics exam</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Electronic equipment (NO CELL PHONES or Smartwatches)</li><li>● Mechanical pencils</li><li>● Books (Dictionaries, etc.)</li><li>● Scratch paper (will be provided when approved)</li><li>● Food or Drink</li><li>● Backpacks/bags</li></ul>

- NO CELL PHONES or SMARTWATCHES! Can't be seen...can't be heard...no exceptions. Turn them off and leave them in your bag.
- Arrive to exams early...Don't be late!
  - 8:00 Exams: Must be in room by 7:45
  - 12:00 Exams: must be in room by 11:45
- Calculus AB and BC exams are on May 5<sup>th</sup>...We do **NOT** have school on that day, but exams will still take place.
