

INTERVENTIONS FOR PHONOLOGICAL AWARENESS
Drop and Say

Purpose:

The student will manipulate phonemes in words.

Description:

Drop and Say

Materials:

1. Drop and Say Triangles (see attached)
2. Drop and Say Picture Cards (see attached)
3. Game Pieces

Procedure/Steps:

1. Place Drop and Say picture cards face down in a stack in the center. Provide each student with a different Drop and Say triangle.
2. Taking turns, student selects the top picture card from the stack and name the picture (ex: “deer”).
3. Delete initial phoneme and say resulting word (ex: “deer” becomes “ear”). Student looks for the new word on the triangle. If found, cover the word using a game piece. If not found, place the picture card at the bottom of the stack.
4. Continue until all pictures on triangle are covered.
5. Final sound game cards are also included.

Evaluation of Effectiveness:

Compare AIMSweb Phoneme Segmentation data before and after the intervention.
