

INTERVENTIONS FOR PHONOLOGICAL AWARENESS
The Sound Game

Purpose:

The student will segment phonemes in words.

Description:

The Sound Game

Materials:

1. The Sound Game board.
2. Two-to-five phoneme picture cards.
3. Game pieces.

Procedure/Steps:

1. Place the Sound Game board and phoneme picture cards face down in a stack. Place game pieces at START.
2. Taking turns, students pick up a picture card, name the picture, and segment the word into phonemes (tie,/t/i/).
3. Move game piece the corresponding number of spaces.
4. Continue until all students reach the END space.

Evaluation of Effectiveness:

Compare AIMSweb Phoneme Segmentation data before and after the intervention.
