Important Safety Update to Automated Attendance Notifications

Beginning on Monday, April 1st, MCCSC is changing the automated notification system from an evening attendance report to a morning attendance notification to occur no later than 11:00 a.m. every day. If your child is absent from school and you have not called the attendance office to inform them of this absence, you will receive a call. This change is being implemented corporation wide to strengthen our school safety protocols and to assist us in knowing the whereabouts of your child during school hours, should they be marked absent. If your child is going to be absent from school, please notify the attendance office as soon as possible. We appreciate your patience as we transition to this new protocol.
