## PBIS News & Notes

**Next week's Positive Behavior skill focus is listening. Listening at school helps you be your best learning you! You need a calm and quiet body, eyes on the teacher, and listening ears. Here are the steps:**

- **Look at the person who is talking and remain quiet.**
- **Wait until the person is through talking before you talk.**
- **Show that you heard the speaker by nodding your head or saying, "Okay."**

**Try this at home: Take a listening walk! What can you hear? When you are on your walk, how are the sounds around you different when you talk and when you listen? Do you hear new sounds when you stop and listen at the same time? When do you hear the smallest sounds? What makes you a good listener?**
