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Frequently Asked Questions regarding Medication Pick Up in the event of a school closure

Q: Where will I pick up my student's medication?

A: At your student's school.

Q. When will I pick up my student's medication?

A: The day following the closure from 11am-2pm.

Q: What if I cannot pick up the medication the day following the closure?

A: A second medication pick up time will be offered on the next Food Pick Up day following the school closure. Food Pick Up days are M, W, F 11am-2pm

Q: Who can pick up my student's medication?

A: The student's parent/guardian or any emergency contact listed in your student's Skyward profile.

Q. What if I need someone other than the parent/guardian or someone listed in my student's Skyward profile to pick the medication up?

A: If you need someone outside of the above criteria to pick up the medication, please provide a signed, written statement of the adult individual (cannot be a student) you grant permission to pick the medication up.

Q: Will I need a photo ID to pick up medication?

A: Yes, individuals will be required to show a photo ID when picking up medication.

Q. What if I want my student's medication to stay at the school?

A: Any medications not picked up will be stored in the Health Office at your child's school until school resumes.
