Students can pick up meals at any of the school sites or alternate locations listed below.

Location: Main entrance of All School Sites & alternate sites listed below

Pickup time: 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Pickup day: Monday, Wednesday and Friday

Food packages will include 2 breakfast meals and 2 lunch meals per student in each family on Monday and Wednesday and 1 breakfast and 1 lunch on Friday. All food items will be labeled with the product name and allergens\*\*.

3. Q. Do I need identification?  
A. Parents will be asked for your students name and their home school.
4. Q. Is a printed menu available?  
A. The menu is posted on the Food Service Web page
5. A. How do I know how many carbs are in an item and what the allergens are?  
Q. Nutritional data and allergens are available on the web menu by hovering over the menu item. Allergen labels are also included on the individual food items.
6. Q. Will meals be available for pick-up outside of the advertised time window?  
A. No, meal pick-up is limited to 11:00a.m. to 2:00p.m. every other day beginning with the first day of closure.
