**THIS RESOLUTION SERVES AS A PUBLIC RE-COMMITMENT TO SERVING ALL
STUDENTS IN AN INCLUSIVE SAFE AND WELCOMING ENVIRONMENT.**

WHEREAS, the Monroe County Community School Corporation (MCCSC) established the mission of;

Empowering students to maximize their educational success, to become productive, responsible global citizens.

AND WHEREAS, the Monroe County Community School Corporation (MCCSC) established the vision of;

A world-class learning community that educates tomorrow's leaders,

AND WHEREAS, the Monroe County Community School Corporation (MCCSC) established the Core Values of;

Engage, Empower, Educate,

AND WHEREAS, the Monroe County Community School Corporation (MCCSC) established Engagement as;

All students can learn. We teach all students. No exceptions.

All students deserve rigorous, diverse curricular and extracurricular programs, integrated with technology. Such programs balance student's needs and interests, resulting in high levels of student engagement, achievement and completion.

AND WHEREAS, the Monroe County Community School Corporation (MCCSC) established Empowerment as;

All students are diverse and unique. When students are empowered, self-esteem grows.

All students' experiences and perspectives are assets that reflect the strength of our schools and the values of our community. Such assets, when respected, nurtured and explored, promote their academic success and the success of their peers.

AND WHEREAS, the Monroe County Community School Corporation (MCCSC) established Environment as;

All students thrive in a positive, creative and stimulating learning and working environment.

All employees excel in a culture actively supported by professional development opportunities. Highly trained, highly valued teachers and staff are pivotal to the continuous improvement and success of our students. All students deserve, and we will provide, a healthy, safe and secure learning environment.

AND THE MCCSC clearly articulates its non-discrimination policy as;

The School Board does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, sex, disability, sexual orientation, marital status, genetic information, gender identity or any other legally protected characteristic, in its programs or activities including employment opportunities.

WHEREAS, U.S. Immigration and Custom Enforcement's (ICE) longstanding policy states that it will not conduct immigration enforcement activity at any sensitive location, which includes schools as well as scholastic or educational related activities or events and school bus stops that are marked and/or known to the office, during periods when school children are present at a stop.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board continues to declare the Corporation to be a Safe Place for students, meaning that the Corporation is a place for students to learn, thrive, and seek assistance, information, and support.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that if state, local, or school law enforcement agencies again on behalf of ICE, or agents or officers for any federal, state or local agency attempting to enforce federal immigration laws, the Corporation shall continue to use the following process to ensure student safety;

1. Corporation personnel shall not inquire about a student's, student's parent or guardian, or eligible student's immigration status.
2. Should ICE or other immigration law enforcement agents request any student information, the request should be referred to the Principal who will work in conjunction with the Assistant Superintendent, Director of Student Services, and legal counsel.
3. Request for students by legal authority will be given to the Principal who will work with the Assistant Superintendent, Director of Student Services, and legal counsel, and parents, and may work with Counselors/Social workers to ensure the safety of students.
4. Requests must be provided with adequate notice so the corporation may take the steps to provide the emotional and physical safety of students and staff.


SO IT BE RESOLVED that the MCCSC clearly supports all as named and mentioned to provide a quality, safe, caring, nurturing learning environment for each and every student.
