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Student and Legal Guardian Agreement The Academy Of Science and Entrepreneurship

The Academy of Science and Entrepreneurship is a districtwide optional school, which means, in part, that enrollment at The Academy is a choice and not a right. Students choose to attend because of a desire to pursue the educational opportunities presented at the Academy and therefore the District expects all students to fully participate in The Academy and to contribute positively to the program's success. To ensure all students and their families understand the expectations of The Academy and their responsibilities, all students and their legal guardian must sign this agreement as a condition of enrollment in The Academy. Signing this agreement does not guarantee a student's admission.

Students:

1. I will maintain prompt and regular school attendance and report for class each day ready for instruction.
2. I will put forth my best effort toward all of my academic work. I will complete assigned homework every night, actively participate in class, ask questions when I don't understand, and seek extra help when needed.
3. If I am absent, upon returning to school, I will submit required documentation for my absence and take responsibility to obtain missed assignments and to make up any missed assignments the following school day or as directed by my instructor(s).
4. I will be a positive and active participant in all aspects of The Academy programs including, but not limited to, field trips, academic counseling, group discussions, projects, testing, and all other instruction or activities presented by the staff.
5. I am responsible for my own behavior and I agree to comply with all the rules and policies of The Academy set out in the Student Handbook that I will receive at the beginning of the school year. I understand that if I do not comply with the rules for The Academy I will be subject to appropriate consequences as outlined in the Student Handbook.
6. I agree to complete at least one year at The Academy.
7. I understand that I will be required to complete multiple college courses in order to complete my high school diploma and I am ready for this additional academic challenge. I understand that as a student at The Academy I will be awarded all of the academic privileges, rights, and responsibilities of being enrolled as a college student.
