

# EARN A CERTIFICATE OF MULTILINGUAL PROFICIENCY



The Indiana Certificate of Multilingual Proficiency is an award designated on a student's transcript that shows that the student has attained a high level of proficiency, sufficient for meaningful use in college and a career in one or more languages in addition to English.

## ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- **Earn six credits in a single language through coursework**  
\*If a student enrolls already proficient in a world language, a score of intermediate high on the World Language assessment can automatically earn a student six world language credits.
- **Pass one of four approved world language assessments at an intermediate high level of proficiency**
- **Earn 8 credits in English/Language Arts**
- **Pass the English Language Arts assessment required for graduation**

## ASSESSMENT INFORMATION

- Several assessment options are available to eligible students
- Funding to offset the costs of assessments is available to students who meet the financial need criteria
- The assessment window is **January 27, 2020 -April 3, 2020**
