### To be treated in the Health Office:

- Students must have a completed Emergency Medical Authorization Form on File
- Students must have a Health Office Pass

### Services the Health Office Offers:

### Medications NOT offered in the Health Office:

- Seasonal Allergy Medications
- Cold/Flu Medications
- Cough Drops
- Cough Syrup
- Nasal Spray
- Allergy Eye Drops
- Midol
- Pepto-Bismol
- Anti-Diarrheal Medications

### Over the Counter Medications provided by MCCSC:
