**The Indiana Non Formal Child Development Associate® (CDA) Project Scholarship**, in partnership with the Monroe County Community School Corporation/ Adult Education Program is pleased to announce the availability of scholarships for the upcoming Child Development Associate® (CDA) Credential course.

To be eligible for the scholarship you must meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Be a resident of Indiana who is at least 18 years of age.
- ✓ High School Diploma or High School Equivalency Diploma (HSE)
- ✓ Be employed in a licensed, registered, or certified early care and education setting working 25+ hrs/week in Indiana for at least 6 months
- ✓ Earn \$20/hr or less as a teacher/teacher assistant OR director/administrator.
- ✓ **Have reliable internet access and a computer to fully participate in the course and be successful.**
