Week 1 (March 25-27)	Draw your Favorite Stuffed Animal or Toy	<i>Pick your favorite animal or toy and set it on a table in front of you. Set your drawing paper on the table and draw a picture of your toy!</i>
Week 2 (March 30- April 3)	Draw from your Imagination: Create a new animal and draw a picture of it	<i>You might pick your two (or three, or four!) favorite animals and combine them to make a new one! OR you could make up a new animal all together!</i>

<p>Week 4 (April 13-17)</p>	<p>Draw your favorite memory</p>	<p><i>Do you have a favorite memory? An awesome birthday party, a vacation, a trip to the park, or something else? Close your eyes and remember what it looked like! Draw your favorite memory on a piece of paper.</i></p>
<p>Week 5 (April 20-24)</p>	<p>Draw your favorite season</p>	<p><i>What is your favorite season? What kind of things do you do in that season? You might draw a scene of something you like to do in your favorite season OR you might just draw what it looks like outside during your favorite season.</i></p>
<p>Week 6 (April 27-May 1)</p>	<p>Draw yourself as royalty</p>	<p><i>What would you look like if you were royal? How would you dress? How would you do your hair? Where would you live? What might you be holding in a royal portrait?</i></p>
