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Post COVID-19 Infection Return to Play for Student Athletes

Per guidance from the Indiana High School Activities Association (IHSAA), Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH), the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP), and the National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS) all student athletes that test positive for COVID-19 must have a documented medical release from a medical provider clearing the student to participate in practice and/or competition.

Once the medical clearance is received, an MCCSC Health Services staff member will contact the family of the student, along with the athletic director informing them that the the student athlete may return to activity. Please note, that the student will not be able to participate without MCCSC Health Services clearance.

10 Day Quarantine for Close Contact

With summer programming MCCSC will be moving to a 10 day quarantine to return to the classroom. However, students may not return to extracurricular activities until day 15. **Please note that if your student can provide proof of full vaccination and are asymptomatic they will not need to quarantine.**
