Student Screening for On-Site School and School Sponsored Extra-Curricular Activities

Please assess your student daily before getting on a school bus or driving/walking to school or school sponsored extra-curricular activities for the following symptoms of COVID-19:

- Fever (100.4 degrees Fahrenheit) or chills
- Newly developed cough
- Newly developed shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Newly developed muscle or body aches
- Newly developed loss of taste or smell
- Newly developed sore throat

If your student has any of the symptoms above, please contact their medical provider and please contact the attendance line at your student's school.

Your student is excluded from on-site school and school sponsored extra-curricular activities until:

- They are symptom free and it has been 10 days from the onset of symptoms, unless otherwise specified in a statement from a medical provider that the student is able to return to on-site school and school sponsored extra-curricular activities sooner.
- Fever free (under 100.4) for 3 consecutive days without the use of a fever reducing medication.

A statement from a medical provider stating that your student is cleared to be on-site at school and/or school sponsored extra-curricular activities is required before reporting to on-site school and/or school sponsored extra-curricular activities.

Please encourage your student to notify their teacher if they develop any of the above symptoms during the school day.

Please see below for additional exclusionary criteria:

Positive COVID-19 diagnosis:

-If your student has been diagnosed with COVID-19 please provide documentation from a medical provider that the student is cleared to be on-site at school and/or school sponsored extra-curricular activities.

-If someone living in the home with your student has been diagnosed with COVID-19, the student is excluded from on-site school and/or school sponsored extra-curricular activities until it has been 14 days since their last exposure to the individual with COVID-19.
