

# Dear South Families,

At the most recent School Board meeting on August 25<sup>th</sup>, the Board approved a Re-Entry plan that has three phases: Red, Yellow, and Green.

Phase Red: All students 100% Online

Phase Yellow: In Person students return to school on an alternating-day schedule

OR students remain 100% Online

Phase Green: In Person students return to school five days a week

OR students remain 100% Online

At the same meeting, the School Board also approved that we would begin Phase Yellow on Tuesday, September 8<sup>th</sup>. As we begin Phase Yellow, our schedule will alternate days by alpha.

## In Person Students

If you were registered for hybrid or five-day, you are registered as an In Person student. Please note the Phase Yellow plan that the School Board has approved beginning September 8<sup>th</sup> has all students attending on alternating days.

Future determinations will be made on a weekly basis using the corporation's Metric Committee which studies daily the impact of COVID-19. This data will be used as part of the information that will determine future movement into any of the other phases.

In Phase Yellow, In Person students will attend every other day (alternating Fridays) and continue to do online work on the days not in attendance.

In Phase Green, all In Person students will attend five days a week.

SRT will occur for In Person students on Monday (A-K) and Tuesday (L-Z).

### 100% Online Students

100% Online students will keep the same schedule and teachers they currently have. Teachers will be teaching 100% Online students concurrent with In Person students.

Lessons will continue to be live recordings. Online Live time will allow students to communicate with their teachers via Teams (links in Canvas) in order to get real time support on their courses.

All classes will have Online Live time during 15 minutes of each class. 100% Online students will be able to log into Microsoft Teams and engage with their teachers as well as the In Person students in that period.

100% Online students will attend SRT meetings via Microsoft Teams during the regularly scheduled SRT time on the following days:

A-K: Online SRT on Tuesdays

L-Z: Online SRT on Mondays
