



Bloomington Graduation School Opening Plan- Fall 2020

Area/Event	What Will It Look Like?
Entrance	Students will continue to use Door #9 for both their arrival and dismissal. The entry will have sanitizing mats to be used upon entering the building. Signage will be posted throughout the building to reinforce social distancing and hand washing procedures.
Main Office	Students will be permitted into the Main Office as needed and available.
Restrooms	The number of students using the restrooms at any given time will be limited to ensure appropriate social distancing.
Hallways	Students will need to follow expected traffic patterns in the hallways - utilizing the right hand side of the hallways to ensure appropriate social distancing. Congregating in the hallways will not be permitted.
Classrooms	B.G.S. will continue to have a maximum teacher/student ratio of 1:15. Students will be expected to face the same direction and their tables will be arranged in a manner to ensure appropriate social distancing. Instruction may be delivered outside, as weather permits.
Cafeteria	Students will only use the cafeteria to pick up their breakfast and lunch. Meals will be eaten in the classroom or outside, as weather permits.
Water Fountains	Water fountains will be turned off. Students may bring water bottles from home. They will be able to fill them at the water bottle filling station as needed.
Lockers	Students will be encouraged to minimize locker use to ensure appropriate social distancing.
Arrival	Students may be dropped off outside of Door #9 (west side door off of South Brown Avenue). It should be noted that students will not be permitted inside the school until 7:30 a.m.
Dismissal	Students may be picked up outside Door #9 (west side door off of South Brown Avenue). Parents/families are encouraged to park along the west or south side of the school building while waiting for students to be dismissed at 2:30 p.m.
Breakfast	Students will pick up their breakfast in the cafeteria and eat it in their 1st Period classroom. While waiting patiently in line, students will need to practice appropriate social distancing.
Lunch	Students will pick up their lunch in the cafeteria and eat it in their Dragons Lair classroom. While waiting patiently in line, students will need to practice appropriate social distancing.
Intervention	The school day consists of two tutorials that provide students with opportunities to get extra help. Additionally, Dragons Lair provides students with additional accountability and support.
Clubs/Events	These will be held virtually first semester.
Visitors	Follow corporation procedures. No visitors will be allowed in buildings. To contact B.G.S., please call (812)330-7708. Meetings with administration and teachers can be arranged virtually.
Guest Teachers	Teachers will continue to be encouraged to be in their classroom each and every day. In the event of a teacher's absence, faculty and staff will work together to provide classroom coverage as able. Guest teachers may be utilized as needed.
Lunch Coverage	Lunch coverage will be provided by a combination of non-teaching faculty and staff.
Handwashing	Students will wash their hands upon their arrival to school, prior to and after meals, and during passing

Self Screening	<p>Every family must complete a daily self screening of each child.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fever (100.4 degrees Fahrenheit)• Chills• Cough• Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing• Fatigue• Muscle or body aches• Headache• New loss of taste or smell• Sore throat• Congestion or runny nose• Nausea or vomiting • Diarrhea <p>Parents should inform the school principal if a student is experiencing symptoms related to COVID-19 and the student should not report to school. Then contact your medical provider to rule out COVID-19.</p>
Facial Coverings	<p>Facial Coverings are required for students and staff throughout the school day. Facial Coverings may only be removed under the following conditions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. During breakfast/lunch, if students are social distanced of six (6) feet or more2. During outdoor recess, if socially distanced of six (6) feet or more3. During a maximum of 3-5 minute break, if socially distanced of six (6) or more feet, with all desks facing the same direction.
