



Bloomington High School North School Opening Plan- Fall 2020

Schedule	What Will It Look Like?
Hybrid	<p>Students will attend in-person class two to three times weekly. A-K: Mondays (Maroon) /Wednesday (Gold) / Alternate Fridays L-Z: Tuesday (Maroon) /Thursday (Gold) /Alternate Fridays</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• While in the building, students will receive all of their instruction from their assigned teachers.• Student school days will follow a Block Schedule, with periods for four classes plus Success Period/DEN.• Students will receive recorded lessons and work via Canvas on online learning days (i.e. A-K on Tuesday, Thursday; L-Z on Monday, Wednesday; alternating Fridays).• Families will have siblings attending on the same day for ease of transportation and to support family scheduling. Families with children who have different last names can request to attend on the same day.
Online	<p>Students will receive recorded instruction, lessons and work via Canvas from their assigned teachers.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students will maintain their 4 period schedule and classes/teachers within their current schedule.• Current schedules can be viewed in Skyward Family/Student Access. Inquiries can be directed to counselors.• Teachers are teaching in-person and online concurrently. Teachers will respond within 48 hours to inquiries from online students.• The work may require scheduled meeting time with teachers and flexibly scheduled independent work.
Five Day In-Person	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students will follow their current four period plus Success Period/Den schedule alternating between Maroon and Gold days.• Classes will be relocated to larger spaces or outdoors as needed to maximize social distancing opportunities. <p><i>Note:</i> MCCSC is surveying families regarding the potential option of five days of instruction if social distancing can be accomplished.</p>
Weekly Syllabus/Planning	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• For consistency of all courses and learning options, teachers will develop/publish a weekly plan on Canvas including assignments, assessments, due dates, etc.• In the event of any short/long term closings, this will allow for consistent and equitable instruction.• Teachers will create an awareness of when recorded lessons will be available per class.



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Hoosier Hills	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Hoosier Hills students will attend Hoosier Hills 5 days/week in person during that portion of their schedule.• Students may attend Hoosier Hills in person and online for BHSN classes.• Choose online in the registration.
Self Screening	<p>Every family must complete a daily self screening of each child.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fever (100.4 degrees Fahrenheit)• Chills• Cough• Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing• Fatigue• Muscle or body aches• Headache• New loss of taste or smell• Sore throat• Congestion or runny nose• Nausea or vomiting• Diarrhea <p>Parents should inform the school principal if a student is experiencing symptoms related to COVID-19 and the student should not report to school. Then contact your medical provider to rule out COVID-19.</p>
Clinic	<p>A separate room will be utilized for students displaying Covid symptoms. 2 rooms in health office: Room 1: for COVID symptoms Room 2: for other medical issues</p>



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Entrance	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Social distancing floor indicators will be marked leading up to the door entrances at Doors: #1, #3, #26.• To ensure everyone's safety, visitors will not be allowed in the building. Visitors must use Door #1 (Main Entrance) using the video intercom to speak with front office staff rather than entering the building. Office staff will meet you to address your visitation needs.• Late student arrivals will be processed through the main office for check-in and then will proceed to class.• All entry doors will have sanitizing mats to be used upon building entry.• The entrances will remain secure.
Main Office	<p>The main office will be restricted. Item drop-off or pick-up will be done in the school vestibule. Video or teleconferencing will be utilized for parent meetings. Students will request meetings electronically via emails or Canvas to meet with administrators or counselors. Individual student meetings will be held while adhering to social distancing guidelines. We look forward to safely seeing our teachers and students, so Main Office doors will be clearly marked Entry/Exit for flow and social distancing. Forms (e.g., attendance, hall passes, etc.) will be digitized to reduce traffic flow in hallways and offices.</p>
Restrooms	<p>Facial coverings are required and signage will promote proper hygiene. Faculty and staff will monitor the spaces to promote social distancing. Restrooms will be cleaned and sanitized between each class period.</p>
Hallways	<p>Students, staff, and faculty will wear facial coverings in the hallways at all times. Hallways and stairwells will be one way with appropriate signage to reduce traffic flow, when possible. Students will travel through hallways on the right side of the hall to promote social distancing.</p>
Classrooms	<p>Class sizes will be reduced or relocated to larger space. Student desks will be spaced to provide social distancing, and all student desks will face the same direction. Teachers will also have the option to use outdoor spaces for instruction. Larger classes will move to larger spaces, including outdoors, to accommodate social distancing.</p> <p>Classroom Sanitizing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Hand sanitizing stations will be available in each room.• Shared supplies will be sanitized between each period.• Seating charts will be kept for contact tracing purposes.• Larger classes may move to additional larger spaces within the building and outside, as weather permits.



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Cafeteria	<p>A uniform traffic flow will move students into the cafeteria through the Commons entrance and out of the cafeteria through three separate points at cafeteria dismissal ensuring social distancing.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Seating will be reduced to limit capacity (200 students) and promote safe social distancing using other large spaces for eating (gymnasium, outdoors, etc.).• Floor markings will indicate social distancing in meal lines.• An additional lunch period has been added (we will now have four lunch periods) to allow for reduced number of students during lunch periods.
Gym	<p>Gym classes will run in our schedule with protocols for facial coverings; social distancing; and utilizing outdoor space whenever possible. The gym facility may be used for larger instructional space when needed for social distancing.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Extracurricular events hosted in the gyms will follow protocols established by MCCSC and event attendance guidelines set by Indiana High School Athletic Association (IHSAA).
Water Fountains	<p>All water fountains in the building are shut off. Bottle filling stations are operational, and all students are encouraged to carry a water bottle.</p>
Lockers	<p>Lockers will not be used. PE lockers will be spaced apart per class and cleaned in between each period.</p>
Library	<p>The library will be open for student and classroom use when not being used for larger classroom space to accommodate social distancing. Students will be allowed to make their book selections through the library staff who will then distribute their selections accordingly.</p> <p>Returned books will be disinfected and must sit 24 hours before being returned to the shelves. Social distancing will be enforced during library use.</p>
Arrival	<p>Bus riders will use Door #26. Walkers and car riders will use Door #1. Student drivers using the upper lot will use Door #3. Student drivers using lower lot will use Door #26</p> <p>Entry into the building will begin at 7:30am. Students not eating breakfast should arrive between 7:45-7:55am daily to promote social distancing. Sanitizing mats will be at each entrance for disinfecting shoes.</p>
Dismissal	<p>Students will be released by PODS/Departments, staggered to support social distancing. Bus riders will use Door #26 and car riders will use Door #1. Student drivers will use Door #3 (upper lot) or #26 (lower lot).</p>
Breakfast	<p>Students will enter the cafeteria for breakfast through the Commons. Seating will be reduced to limit capacity and promote safe social distancing. Students will remain in the cafeteria until released for class.</p>
Lunch	<p>Four lunch periods will be scheduled. The gymnasium will be used for overflow seating and will provide space for 200 students per lunch period to eat at a safe</p>



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Electives	Electives are built into students' course schedules and are part of their normal class rotation.
Intervention	Success Period/Tutorial scheduler will be used.
Library Book Distribution	The library will be accessible to students for book check out. Returned books will be disinfected and must sit 24 hours before being returned to the shelves. Social distancing will be enforced during library check out and return.
Band	Band will utilize outdoor spacing and additional room space to provide for social distancing for larger classes. Scheduled start date 7/20 following MCCSC and ISSMA guidelines.
Strings/Orchestra	Orchestra will utilize additional large rooms to provide for social distancing for larger classes following MCCSC and ISSMA guidelines.
Choir	Large choir class(es) will hold class in the auditorium to allow for maximum social distancing and follow MCCSC and ISSMA guidelines. Classes will be held outdoors, when weather permits.
Athletics	Athletics programs will operate under the MCCSC/IHSAA Phased Athletic Return to Play Plan.
Clubs/ Extracurricular Events	Clubs may meet provided school and corporation guidelines can be met and proper social distancing and wearing facial coverings is maintained, per building schedule. Virtual options will be used when social distancing is a consideration. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Approved events will follow CDC, IHSAA and local Health Department guidelines and guidance.
Visitors	Visitors will not have building access during the school day. Conferences and meetings will be conducted by video or phone.
Guest Teachers	Guest teachers will follow established check-in protocols with the main office and will be provided building-specific information on safety practices and protocols. They will wear facial coverings at all times. Support will be provided by the office or neighboring teachers as needed.
Lunch Coverage	Lunch periods will be monitored and supervised to ensure social distancing.
Handwashing Schedule	Students will wash hands upon arrival to school, before and after meals, and during passing periods and restroom use.
Facial Coverings	Facial Coverings are required for students and staff throughout the school day. Facial Coverings may only be removed under the following conditions: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. During breakfast/lunch, if students are social distanced of six (6) feet or more2. During outdoor recess, if socially distanced of six (6) feet or more3. During a maximum of 3-5 minute break, if socially distanced of six (6) or more feet, with all desks facing the same direction.
