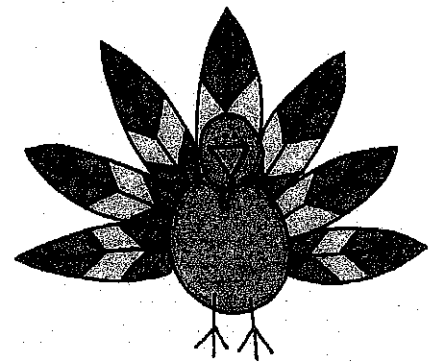

Childs Elementary is proud to announce that we are one of 13 schools in Indiana honored with being certified as an Eco-Friendly School by the National Wildlife Federation (NWF.) We have recently moved from the bronze level to the silver level for the efforts of students and educators in effective "green" managing of our school grounds, facility, and curriculum.

Schools are awarded levels based on the incorporation of a variety of environmental pathways. Childs has focused on ENERGY, WASTE CONSUMPTION, BIODIVERSITY, SCHOOL GROUNDS, SUSTAINABLE FOOD, TRANSPORTATION, and HEALTHY SCHOOLS and LIVING. This year we have added the recycling of markers to help reduce waste. We are also focusing furthering our energy savings and addressing transportation by raising awareness of the benefits of a NO-IDLE zone in the student pick-up area. Please do not idle if weather permits. This is just one small step in making a big difference for our environment.

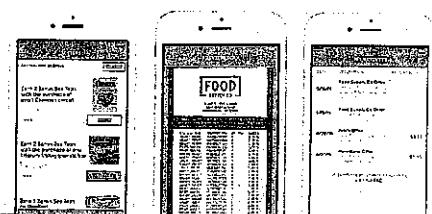
