School Day: Full Day Kindergarten is free to all students. The school hours are 9:00-3:45.

Attendance:

- Students are expected to attend school every day.
- Contact the school right away if your child will be absent. Most schools have an automated system to report absences.
- Excused absences include illness, observance of a religious holiday, recovery from an accident, professional appointments and death in the immediate family. Other absences may be excused. Talk with your school principal.
- If your child misses more than 10 days of school you will receive a letter from the school corporation.

Custody:

- If you have been awarded custody of a student by the courts, please provide the school with a copy of the custody order as soon as possible.
- Inform the school in writing of any limitations in the rights of the non-custodial parent.

Early Entrance Students:

If your child turns 5 years old between August 2 and August 31 you may request that he/she enter school early. You must complete an Early Kindergarten Appeal Request. This request must be returned to your child's school by August 1st. Early Entrance students are NOT automatically enrolled in school. You will receive a response right before school starts. Please make alternative plans for your child in case they are not accepted into Kindergarten. Early entrance depends upon space available and kindergarten class sizes. Please call 330-7700 if you have any questions about this process.

Breakfast and Lunch:

Students are assigned a PIN number to access their account. Teachers and other staff will help students through the lunch line the first few days of school. Students may also bring their lunch. At the beginning of the year, you will also be given the option to complete the *APPLICATION FOR FREE AND REDUCED-PRICE MEALS & OTHER BENEFITS* forms.

Adding Money to Your Family Meal Account:

You can send cash, check, or money order to school with your child. Include a note with your child's name and teacher. Please write your child's name on the "Note" line on your check. You can also transfer money from a bank account to your family account using the MCCSC website to make online payments.

Textbook/Resource Rental Fee:

MCCSC charges a textbook rental/materials fee for Kindergarten. A bill will be mailed in the fall. Families who qualify for free or reduced-price meals will not be charged a textbook/materials fee. In order to receive this waiver, you must answer the other benefits section on the *APPLICATION FOR FREE AND REDUCED- PRICE MEALS & OTHER BENEFITS* forms.

Transportation:

Bus riders will receive a post card listing the bus number, bus stop location, and approximate pick up time right before school starts. If you have not received bus information two days before the start of school, call MCCSC Transportation, 330-7719. Car pick-up and drop-off procedures will be outlined at each school. Please follow those guidelines to ensure the safety of all of our students.

School Age Care Programs:

Before and after school care is available in the school building for a fee. For details on cost and sign-up registration for childcare before and/or after school, contact the office of School Age Care at 330-7702. The extended day morning program begins at 6:30 a.m. and runs until the first bell rings at 8:45 a.m. The extended day after school program begins right after school and runs until 6:00 p.m.

Health Issue or Medication:

If your child has a health issue or takes medication at school, please inform the school prior to the first day of school. The health office will be open before school starts as well as the main office.
