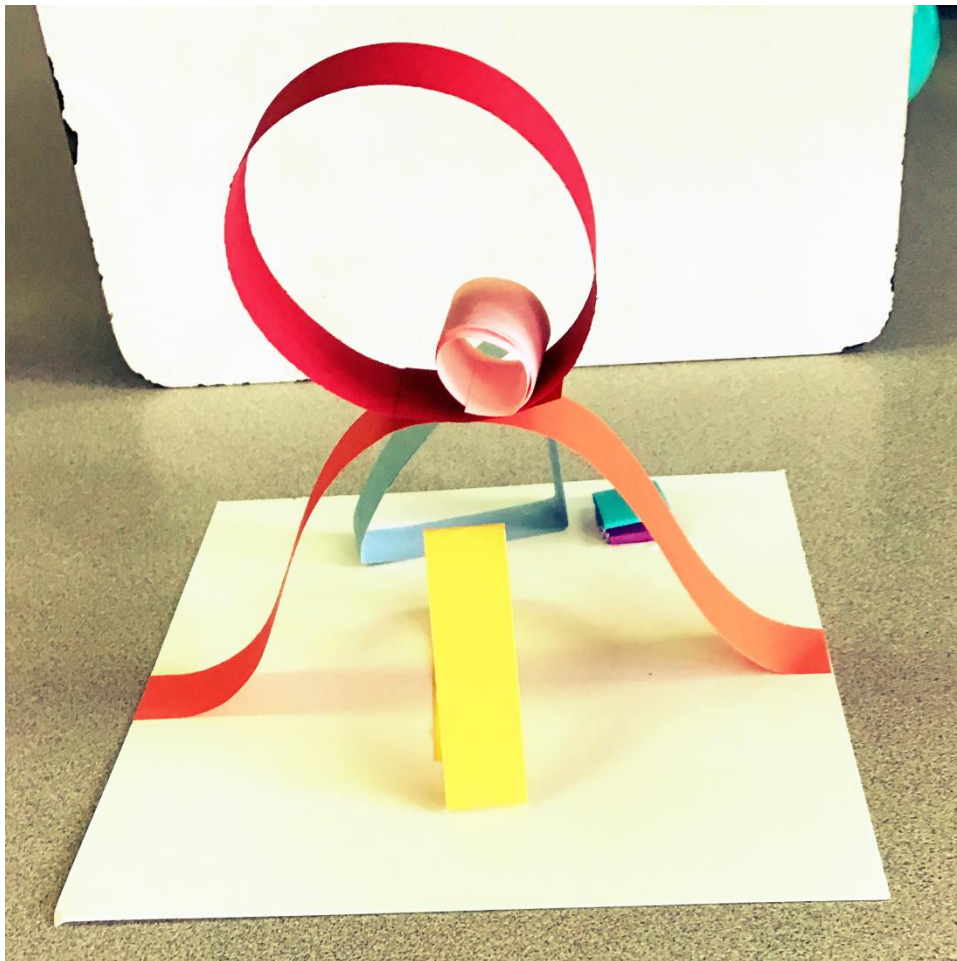
THINK SKILL OF THE WEEK "Appropriate Tone of Voice".
