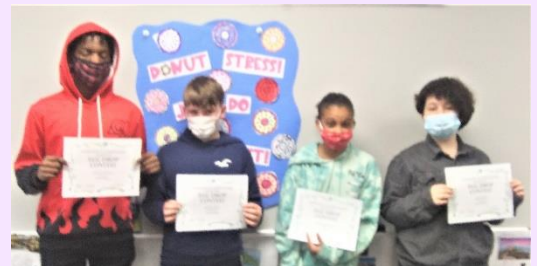
THINK SKILL OF THE WEEK:

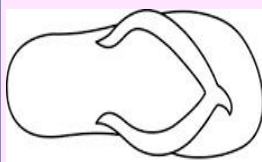


FUN FACT
