Breakfast & Lunch

We know some of our families rely heavily on breakfast and lunch service in our schools. The MCCSC Food Service Department will provide pick-up service at all schools during the closure. Students can pick up meals at any of the school sites.

Location: Main entrance of any MCCSC School

Pickup time: 11:00am to 1:00pm

Pickup day: Monday, Wednesday and Friday

Food packages will include 2 breakfast meals and 2 lunch meals per student in each family on Monday and Wednesday and 1 breakfast and 1 lunch on Friday. All food items will be labeled with the product name and allergens.

In addition to school sites, meals will be available for pick up at additional locations. All pick up sites are listed on the MCCSC website.

YOU GOTTA KEEP MOVIN'!

Set an interval timer and complete each animal movement for 45 seconds, with 15 seconds of rest in between. Do as many as you can!



FROG JUMPS

Hop, hop, back and forth like a frog



BEAR WALK

Hands & feet on the floor, hips high - walk left and right



GORILLA SHUFFLE

Sink into a low sumo squat, with hands on the floor, shuffle around the room.



STARFISH JUMPS

Jumping jacks as fast as you can, with arms and legs spread wide.



CHEETAH RUN

Run in place, as FAST as you can! Just like the fastest animal in the Sahara.



CRAB CRAWL

Sit and place your palms flat on the floor behind you near your hips. Lift up off the ground and crawl.



ELEPHANT STOMPS

March in place lifting your knees as high as you can and stomping the ground as hard as you can!
