Dear Parents,

It is once again time to get this season's flu vaccine. The Monroe County Public Health Clinic is working with your child's school to **give children the flu vaccine at school** so you won't need to miss work.

If your child does not have insurance, has Medicaid, or has insurance that doesn't cover immunizations, there is not a charge for the vaccine. If your child has insurance that covers vaccines at any level, we are required to bill the insurance company. We are able to bill most major insurance companies. Please see the attached form for a list of accepted insurance companies.

Please refer to attached schedule for the date the Flu Clinic will be held at your child's school and the deadline to return paperwork. NO LATE FORMS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

- 1. Completely fill out the attached consent and health questionnaire on the back. If the forms are not completed appropriately your child will not be vaccinated.**
- 2. Be sure to include you insurance ID number if applicable.**
