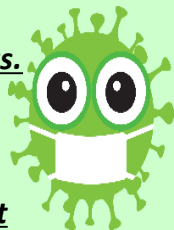

Just a reminder, parents will not be allowed into school buildings this year. Contact us and we will be happy to meet with you by phone or video conferencing.



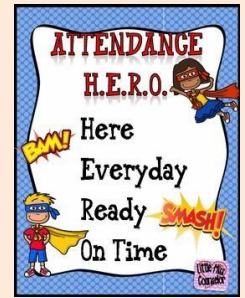
SCHOOL FUN FACT
