“Here Comes the Bus” is an easy-to-use website and mobile device app that enables parents and caregivers to view the real-time location of their child's school bus on a computer, tablet or smartphone. In addition, email alerts and push notifications help parents send their students to the bus stop at just the right time. This application can be viewed on any smart phone (Apple iPhone, Samsung Galaxy, BlackBerry, etc.) Get started by

using herecomesthebus.com and **School Code 82359**.

***Note:** Student ID is the alpha key found in your Skyward account. (Example: ABCDEFGH000 (8 letters followed by 3 digits). There are also options by which parents can reach the transportation office with busing questions and concerns. Parents may call the transportation call center at 812-330-7719. There is now a dedicated e-mail address – bushelp@mccsc.edu. Parents may also use the Tip Line Button on the MCCSC website or the mobile app by selecting the “transportation” category.
