Any items that are not claimed by Spring Break will be discarded or donated!



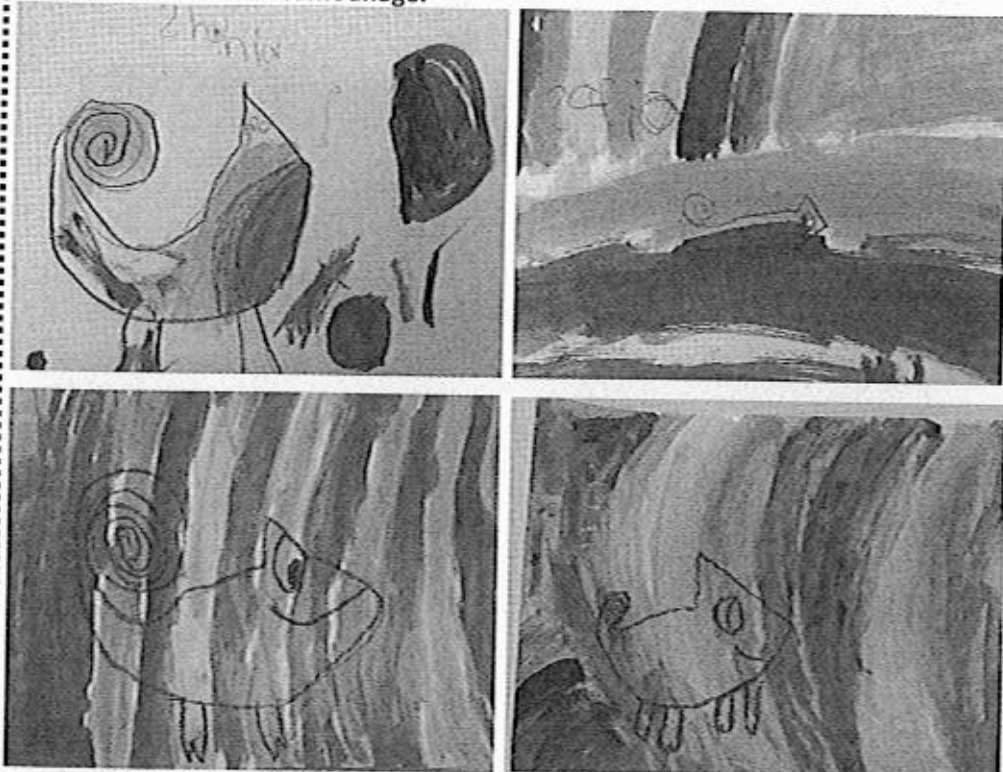
Students celebrated 2/22/22 with two snacks, two dance parties and a “double take” with Mr. Gobert and Mrs. Pearson!
