“Expressing Pride”

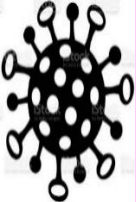
Ask your children if they know the steps:

horizontally - it makes for a complete view.

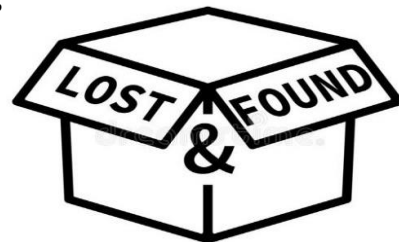
Log Into Family Access

1. Go to www.mccsc.edu
2. Click on Families,
3. Click on Skyward Family Access button -
"first time user".

You will then be sent (via e-mail) your user
name and password. After obtaining your
password, you will then be able to complete a
registration for your student by clicking on the
enrollment button for new students under the
same families tab. Please have your child's
**birth certificate, proof of address and
vaccination records** on hand as these
documents are required to be photographed
and uploaded during the enrollment process.
